### Overview:

In response to concerns raised by Local residents and Lewisham Council, BCM conducted vibration monitoring for works at New Cross Gate in order to protect against liability claims and client reputation.

Vibrating equipment used include hydraulic breakers breaking concrete and on occasion some heavy vibrating rollers used for tarmac surfaces.

BCM conducted regular vibration monitoring which showed no significant vibration within the limits of the Section 61 agreement and which reassured both the council and local residents.
